



Match the number on the diagram to the appropriate part of the horse.

- \_\_\_ **Coronet:** A band around the top of the hoof from which the hoof wall grows.
- \_\_\_ **Crest:** The upper part of the neck, from the withers to the ears.
- \_\_\_ **Croup:** The sloping part of the hip between the tail and the loin.
- \_\_\_ **Fetlock:** The leg joint above the pastern and below the cannon bones.
- \_\_\_ **Forearm:** The upper part of the front leg; from the horse's elbow to the knee.
- \_\_\_ **Gaskin:** The muscular part of the hind leg above the hock.
- \_\_\_ **Hock:** The joint in the hind leg that works like the ankle, allowing bend of the lower leg.
- \_\_\_ **Pastern:** The area between the fetlock joint and the coronet band.
- \_\_\_ **Poll:** The bony area lying between the ears.
- \_\_\_ **Stifle:** The joint between the hip and the hock; is similar to the human knee.
- \_\_\_ **Throatlatch:** The point where the horse's head attaches to the neck.
- \_\_\_ **Withers:** The highest point of the horse's shoulders.
