| _____ Bumper | A. A belly band or strap around the horse's body that keeps the saddle or harness in place. |
| _____ Bosal | B. Side pieces on a bridle so horses cannot see behind them. Often used on driving or racing horses. |
| _____ Martingale | C. Leather strap on the bit passing under the horse's chin. |
| _____ Splint Boots | D. Headpiece used on horse's head to keep them from injuring their forehead when traveling in a trailer. |
| _____ Snaffle | E. Leather noseband used to encourage a horse to keep its mouth closed over the bit. |
| _____ Blinders | F. Rawhide noseband used in western training. It is a hackamore type bridle. |
| _____ Surcingle | G. Piece of training equipment used to keep a horse's head from getting too far out of position. |
| _____ Cavesson | H. Strap that encircles the heart girth of the horse and can be firmly fastened down. |
| _____ Girth | I. Protective coverings worn around the cannon bones of the front legs to prevent injury. |
| _____ Curb Strap | J. A single jointed bit with no shanks and a ring on each side of the mouthpiece. |
